CGS update	<p>George reported that we have been awarded another round of funding from the Cleaner, Greener, Safer (CGS) funding from Southwark Council for the development of the old playground on the estate into a community garden.</p> <p>Apollo have offered to manage the work to create a rockery/memorial garden on the other site which had once been a playground. As they will be using their own suppliers, this will cut costs and enable us to get more done for our money.</p> <p>George is meeting with the Project Officer of CGS in order to progress these various pieces of work.</p> <p>George explained that there had also been some discussion around developing the kickabout area on the estate into a new office space and larger community hall. Cllr McNally explained that, as there were several good community meeting spaces locally which the council had invested into, it was unlikely that such a project would attract political support.</p> <p>However, it would be possible to bid for funding in next year's CGS round to develop the space into a multi-use games area.</p> <p>Cllr McNally also advised that it would be best to focus on getting estate improvements right and not trying to spread resources too thinly.</p>
